

# SUPPLIES FOR 2019-20 KINDERGARTEN - 4TH GRADE

### KINDERGARTEN

1 ream white copy paper  
 1 large eraser  
 2 boxes of 8 Crayons, regular size  
 1 pack small Glue sticks (not Elmer's liquid or rolling glue)  
 Fiskars blunt scissors (metal)  
 Box for supplies, plastic (**no larger than 8" x 5"**)  
 No. 2 wooden pencils (**no plastic or glitter coated pencils**)

Watercolor paints, Crayola or Prang brand  
 1 Kleenex (large box)  
 Back pack or book bag  
 8 wide-tipped Crayola markers (classic colors only)  
 1 box of colored pencils  
 1 spiral bound wide-ruled notebook  
 Large disinfectant wipes container  
 2 boxes snacks per month

### FIRST GRADE

Box of Crayons, 24 pack

### SECOND GRADE

No. 2 lead pencils (**not plastic or glitter coated**)  
 8 Glue sticks  
 2 Large pink erasers  
 Box of 24 crayons  
 Fiskars scissors  
 8 Crayola washable markers (optional)  
 Kleenex (large box)  
 School box, about 8" x 4" x 1 3/4" deep  
 1 Clorox wipes  
 2 Dry Erase Markers  
 1 package pencil top erasers  
 Headphones  
 1/2' binder  
 12 pack colored pencils (optional)  
 REQUIRED: Tennis shoes for P.E.

### THIRD GRADE

No. 2 lead pencils-package of 12 (no mechanical pencils)  
 2 large pink erasers  
 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks  
 Scissors (Fiskars recommended)  
 8 white Glue sticks  
 Crayons  
 2 Kleenex (large boxes)  
 2 heavy duty plastic (2 pocket folders)

### THIRD GRADE CONTINUED

Plastic box for supplies
